

The Town Board of Pittsfield held a regular board meeting on Tuesday, February 10, 2015. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Deneys at 7:25 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and an opening prayer. Present for roll were Chairman Deneys, and Supervisor Huetter. Supervisor Tauscher was excused.

Huetter/Deneys, motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to approve the minutes of the January 13, 2015, meeting. Motion carried.

There were no public comments.

Treasurer Harrig's report:

2014 Financial summary indicated a balance of \$115,593.92 remaining in the general fund.

Rescue Squad Report:

Meeting was held Jan. 26, 2015. The general fund has \$13,805, and the equipment fund has \$108,156 available. David Ray has been appointed operation manager to take over the position previously held by Mark Fredrickson. End of the year general fund balance was \$7,150, which will be returned to the municipalities with \$1,422 being returned to Pittsfield. A \$2,000 donation was received from WPS which was used toward the purchase of the new unit. Next meeting will be March 23, 2015.

Fire Dept. Report:

Meeting was held January 27, 2015. Presently have 34 members. Randy Wichlacz is on medical leave. James Styczynski is serving as acting fire chief. Mutual aid training is continuing to be done. Next meeting will be March 24, 2015.

3. Community Park. Working with scouts on projects in the park. Would like to sell the remaining recycling bins as a means of raising additional funds for the park.
4. General code codification moving forward.
