The town board of Pittsfield held a regular board meeting on Tuesday, November 10, 2015. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Deneys, at 7:04 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a short prayer. Present for roll were Chairman Deneys, Supervisor Huetter and Supervisor Tauscher.

Tauscher/Huetter, motion to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to approve the minutes of the October 13, 2015, meeting with the correction to the spelling of culvert. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to approve the report. Motion carried.

Rescue Squad Report:

No meeting held in October. Next meeting will be Nov. 23, 2015.

Fire Dept. Report:

Meeting was held October 27, 2015. Continue to monitor the ladder truck for problems. "I am Responding" software has been approved for training purposes. A new hydrant has been installed in the Town of Chase. Use of the meeting room at the fire station is being discussed. Next meeting will be Dec. 22, 2015. Tauscher/Huetter, motion to accept the report. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to accept the Humane Officers report and place on file. Motion carried.

Planning Report:

1. Discussion on sex offenders residing in the town. Recommend a map be available showing areas for residence not available to convicted sex offenders.
2. Recommend to the board revoking any permits issues for over - weight loads on town roads during thaw season and to apply stricter enforcement when issuing permits in the future.
3. Signs were discussed.
4. Recommend signing Cottonwood Drive to 45 MPH.
5. Rifle hunting was discussed.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to accept the report. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to sign a joint maintenance agreement for Brown County Line Road with the Town of Chase. Motion carried.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to sign a contract with Brandon Holewinski for lawn care and maintenance of the North Pittsfield Cemetery, Community Park, and the Pittsfield Town Hall for 2016. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to require a permit for utilities crossing town roads, issued by the zoning administrator. Motion carried.

As approved by Planning, any existing permits for over-weight loads on town roads during the thaw season will be revoked and letters will be sent to those holding those permits making them aware of the change. Stricter enforcement on applications for over-weight loads will be used.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to sign the sublease of ground lease dated Nov. 9, 1999 with N-sight. Motion carried.

Garbage/recycling program: Deneys/Tauscher motion to the following:

1. Carts are for residential use only.
2. 1 credit per resident for container rental.
3. Clerk and treasurer have authority to bill any missed special assessments or refund if billed by mistake.

Motion carried.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to use the web site and the Pittsfield Town Hall as the legal posting places. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to adopt General Code Ordinance 2015-1 and Schedule A. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to adopt Resolution for General Code. Voice vote: Deneys, Ya, Huetter, Ya, Tauscher, Ya. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to make final payment for reconstruction of Westline for \$5,976.97. Motion carried. Chairman signed the TRIP-D application.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to adjust the ordinance to include Cottonwood Drive speed limit to 45 MPH. Motion carried.

A WPS grand has been applied for to help with the development of the Community Park.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to approve the permits issued by the zoning administrator. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to approve the invoices for current expenses. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to approve checks 11313-11347. Motion carried.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to adjourn at 8:50 p.m. Motion carried.
