The Town Board of Pittsfield held a regular board meeting on Wednesday November 9, 2016. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and an opening prayer. Present for roll were Chairman Deneys, Supervisor Huetter, and Supervisor Tauscher.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to approve the agenda but to eliminate the Planning committee report and Intergovernmental sewer agreement. Motion carried.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to approve the minutes from the October 11 & 18, 2016, meetings. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to approve the report. Motion carried.

Public comments:

Betty Huetter commented on how smoothly the elections ran with the big turnout of voters. Clerk and poll workers were thanked for all their efforts.

A resident was concerned about trucks hauling manure on School Drive because it is a road already in poor condition.

Community Park:

Busy looking for resources to raise money to expand the park.

Humane Officer report.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to receive and place on file the report from the humane officer. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to sign and approve as recommended by planning the sex offender ordinance. Motion carried.

Abandonment of dedicated portion of Kunesh North Road was discussed. After conferring with legal sources it has been decided to leave this as a dedicated road until at such time it is developed by the town or by private persons.

Culvert/water issue Cty C and Anston Road is being worked on and will be addressed again at the December meeting.

Huetter/Tauscher, motion to approve the payment for reconstruction of Pittco Road. Motion carried.

2017 road construction projects were discussed. Board members were asked to look at roads to help determine the most immediate needs for repairs and reconstruction.

Town hall needs: dust to dawn light at the yellow shed will be discontinued and taken down. Repairs are needed at the end of the ramp at the town hall.

Huetter/Deneys, motion to hire Brandon Holewinski to mow the town hall lawn, Pittsfield Community Park, and the North Pittsfield Cemetery for 2017. Motion carried.

Budget levy was discussed. Budget hearing will be November 22, 2016, at 6:00 p.m.

Tauscher/Huetter, motion to approve the permits issued by the building inspector and the zoning administrator. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to approve invoices for current expenses. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to approve checks 11793-11840. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to adjourn to closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats 19.85 (1) (c) to discuss personnel issues and include the clerk and treasurer in the session. Motion carried.

Deneys/Huetter, motion to return to open session. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to allow Chairman Deneys to interview and bring a recommendation back to the board for a person to fill the position of town clerk. Motion carried.

Deneys/Tauscher, motion to adjourn at 9:00 p.m. Motion carried.
