Huetter/Tauscher, motion to deviate from the agenda as needed. Motion carried.

Tauscher /Huetter, motion to approve the printed minutes from the November 14, 2017. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Website seems to be out of date, seems that the service we are receiving are not up to platinum status.

Treasurer Harrig's report: A New Bridge account was set up for earmarked funds

Cash on hand August 2017 \$615,225.35

Income \$47,928.25

Expenses \$66,510.85

Available balance \$596,642.75

Rescue Squad Report: Meeting was held on November 27, 2017 all members were present, the general fund is at \$12,276. And the equipment fund is at \$35,214. There were 44 runs with 5 being in the town of Pittsfield. At this time the budget is running behind, municipalities may need to subsidize the short fall at the end of the year. Write-offs are unexpectedly high, NEW has implemented a few steps to try to cover the short falls. The reconditioning project is almost finished. NEW Rescue has received a grant from the State of Wisconsin in the amount of \$5,871., they will be updating the navigation systems and will escrow the remainder for training. Next meeting will be held on January 22, 2018.

Fire Dept. Report: There was not a meeting held, next meeting will be December 19, 2017

Community Park: Possible Christmas tree shredding at the park on January 13th, 2018

Humane officer report: Huetter/Tauscher, motion to receive and place on file the report from the humane officer. Motion carried.
